The above rates are charged for students only. There is **no charge for adult supervisors (teachers or chaperones)** who accompany your group for the duration of your retreat here up to a maximum of 1 adult per 5 students for elementary and middle school students and up to 1 adult per 7 students for secondary students. Supervisor numbers exceeding this amount will be charged the gr. 8 – 12 rates for the accommodations used.

Adults requesting accommodations other than above will be charged our rental rates.

Our canteen is available to be opened upon request and should be a scheduled event. It includes numerous candy items. Pop machine is on-site and accessible at all times.

The rates for catered meals are based on a minimum group size of 40 students.
