



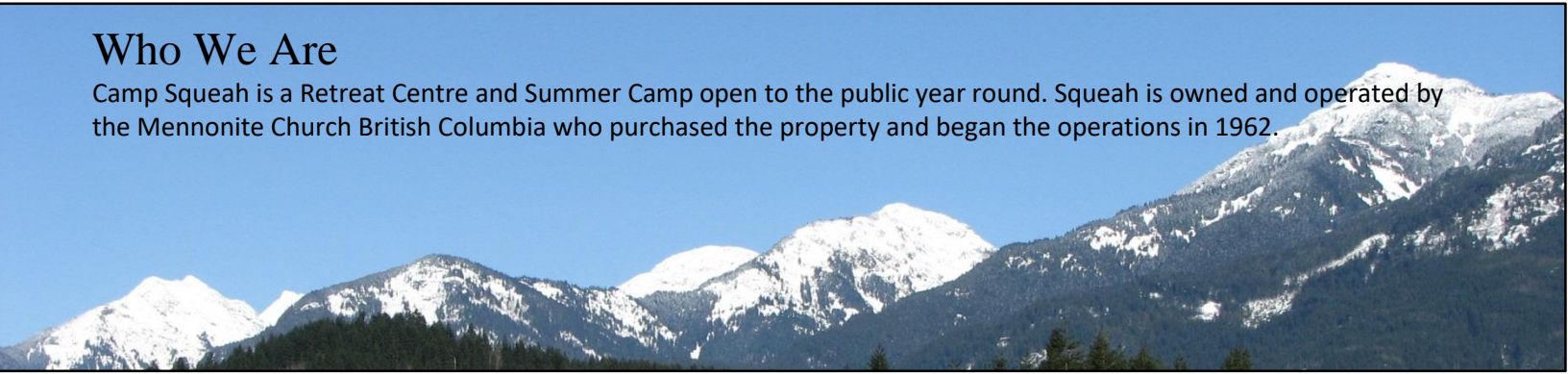

Who We Are

Camp Squeah is a Retreat Centre and Summer Camp open to the public year round. Squeah is owned and operated by the Mennonite Church British Columbia who purchased the property and began the operations in 1962.



Our Mission

In response to God who loves and calls us, Camps Squeah provides a place of refuge in a natural setting where people of all ages can build relationships, grow and be nurtured.

Who We Serve

Camp Squeah is open to the public and serves groups year round. We seek to fulfill our mission statement with all who come to be a part of our community and to enjoy the camp and its setting. We serve as a summer children's camp for children aged 6 – 17 through the summer, offering volunteer opportunities to young adults and families, as well as a family camp for people of all ages.

In the Autumn, Winter and Spring we serve a variety of groups: corporate meetings, family reunions, church gatherings, youth retreats, women's and men's retreats, Outdoor Education events for public, private or religious schools, intentional team building days and others. We are open to groups as small as 10 and as large as we can hold – catering up to 200 in our main lodge!

Our Location

Camp Squeah is nestled in Dogwood Valley on the Fraser River just north of Hope on the #1 Hwy. Situated between the Cascade and Coastal Mountain ranges, our property and beyond is full of small rivers, little lakes, temperate rain forest and the mighty Fraser!

Our Facilities

Our accommodations and meeting rooms provide a range of options from family and adult rooms that are very comfortable to more rustic cabins for summer campers and school students. With over 200 beds, plus space to set up a



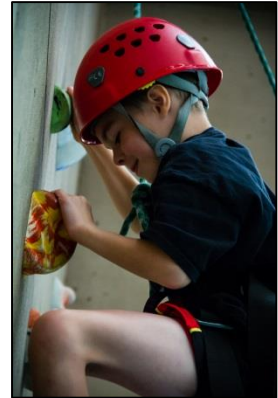
tent or RV if needed, Squeah has room to accommodate small and large groups and to serve their needs. All rooms offered are winterized.



Our Activities

Squeah offers a wide range of activities for guest groups. We pride ourselves on excellent team building activities including use of our low and high ropes courses. Other activities that may interest your group may be Archery, Crafts, Indoor Rock Climbing, Swimming in our pool, Nature Lore, Orienteering, Fire building, Canoeing, Hiking, Overnighting in the woods or Crafts. Some activities are available during specific seasons.

Squeah's location is rich in First Nations history and we've relations with local aboriginal teachers and guides who enjoy sharing their stories, skills, history and culture with groups when requested. Other activities offered through contractors include Falconry, Geology and Gold Panning. The Historic town of Yale is just up the road and the Fraser River gold rush started on the Fraser right near our camp!



Our Grounds

Squeah's property provides a large playing field (field and sports equipment available on request), horseshoe pits, tetherball, a playground, life-sized chess set, multiple fire pits, outdoor sand volleyball, covered gym with hockey and basketball equipment, an indoor games room with billiards, foosball, ping pong and shuffleboard, kilometres of hiking trails to destinations 10 minutes or hours away – mountain tops, alpine lake, rushing mountain river, waterfalls, ponds and the fabled Blessed Hermitage!



Our Food Service

Camp Squeah offers a wide range of great food to meet the needs and demands of busy and active groups at camp. Food for students is healthy, with vegetables and/or fruit available at all meals.

For our adult guests Squeah supplies delicious coffee and tea throughout the day; children can enjoy our juice machine and the best water in Canada. Our meals are typically served cafeteria style and the variety of delicious meals leaves our guests with great memories.

With ever increasing dietary restrictions we do our very best to meet any specific dietary allergy/religious needs or requests. We love to serve and support our guests with excellent and filling meals – food service is one of the great parts of camp!
